- \* Scientific Name: Coriandrum sativum
- \* Family: Parsly (Apiaceae)
- \* Type: Annual Edible Herb
- \* Native range: Europe
- \* Sun: Full sun to part shade
- \* Blooms: Seasonally

\* Attracts: Honey bees, Bumblebees, & Native bees, & Hover flies among others.

\* Cultivated: Alamance County

**Notes:** A warm weather annual that is commonly grown in herb gardens for its lacy, strong-scented foliage (cilantro) and its aromatic seeds (coriander). A nectar and pollen source. Pollen pellets: creamy-white.
