

Coriander (cilantro)

- * Scientific Name: *Coriandrum sativum*
- * Family: Parsly (Apiaceae)
- * Type: Annual Edible Herb
- * Native range: Europe
- * Sun: Full sun to part shade
- * Blooms: Seasonally
- * Attracts: Honey bees, Bumblebees, & Native bees, & Hover flies among others.
- * Cultivated: Alamance County

Notes: A warm weather annual that is commonly grown in herb gardens for its lacy, strong-scented foliage (cilantro) and its aromatic seeds (coriander). A nectar and pollen source. Pollen pellets: creamy-white.
